Bill served as the Vice President for the Operational Logistics Division at LMI, a not-for-profit government consulting firm. He managed LMI's transportation, distribution, joint logistics, defense policy, and integrated logistics programs. Prior to that, Bill was the Vice President for the Logistics Technology Division at LMI where he oversaw logistics systems, automated Information technology (AIT), and in-transit visibility programs. Key customers included United States Transportation Command (USTRANSCOM), Surface Deployment and Distribution Command, the Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense for Transportation Policy, Army Program Executive Office for Enterprise Information Systems (PEO-EIS), and Army Material Command.

In addition to establishing the LMI Midwest Office in support of USTRANSCOM and its components, eventually growing the program to over 40 personnel, Bill led the effort to win LMI's largest contract in support of AESIP for PEO-EIS. He also led the LMI program to implement electronic data interchange (EDI) and AIT in defense transportation, and managed more than 100 studies in defense logistics focusing largely on transportation and distribution efficiency and effectiveness.

Prior to LMI, Bill managed marine, inland transportation, equipment control, and terminal operations for United States Lines in the ports at Baltimore and New York. As Marine Manager, Bill was responsible for container stowage, cargo operations, ship operations, cargo claims, and stevedore and longshore labor while maintaining productivity in a safe environment. As Equipment Control Manager, Bill was responsible for terminal operations, pier-to-pier loading and unloading, inland transportation, and equipment control.

Bill has a bachelor's degree in Economics from Georgetown University, and a Master of Business Administration in Finance from Loyola University. He is also a graduate of the Advanced Management Program from the Information Resource Management College of the National Defense University.
